1. Components Each display must include a clear definition of the problem, and a detailed description of the purpose of the project. There must be a project binder in the display along with a component from each student in the group that may include; pamphlet; poster board; model; simulation; animation; or Power Point	10%		
2. Oral Communication The design team must describe the project and its components orally. The issue being addressed and the reason for selecting this solution must be clearly explained. The team must also be able to describe the advantages and disadvantages of the solution selected, the feasibility of the proposed solution, and the team's ideas for implementing the solution. Some initiative should be demonstrated in the proposed implementation scheme.	20%		
3. Effectiveness of Solution Criteria include: research into current structures and systems in place at Lucas; cost of implementation; complexity of solution; current and future impact on Lucas; longevity or durability of solution	10%		
4. Innovation The display should effectively highlight, demonstrate and communicate innovative concepts incorporated in the design.	10%		
5. Critical Thinking The application of critical thinking in the development of the solution should be clearly documented. Critical Thinking includes design calculations, testing and experiments using proper data collection, use of Why-Why diagrams, and KT analysis. Students should also consider the validity of their resources and use reliable references only.	30%		
6. Written and Graphical Communication The display should effectively convey information about the proposed solution for the issue being addressed. The display should be well organized, well written and effectively formatted. Effective communication includes use of diagrams, models, photographs, graphs and plots, animations, simulations, etc. APA style reference must be included.	20%
