~~It is the policy of the Board that:~~

- 1.0 The Thames Valley District School Board values and welcomes the contributions of diverse community members in strengthening educational opportunities for all students and ensuring a respectful, supportive, and welcoming learning and working environment for all students and employees.
- 24.0 Subject to the provisions of the *Education Act*, all children who are qualified to be resident pupils of the Board, shall be entitled to admission to school subject to the Board's policy and procedure regarding Attendance Areas for Students.
- 32.0 International students, unless exempt under Section 49(7) of the *Education Act*, are to pay tuition fees in accordance with the *Education Act*. Financial Services, on an annual basis, will determine the fees to be charged.
- 43.0 Students from another province within Canada or outside Canada who are Canadian citizens and/or permanent residents of Canada, and whose parents or legal guardians do not reside in Ontario, may be required to pay tuition fees in accordance with the *Education Act* unless certain criteria are met. ~~Financial Services~~ International Education will determine whether or not tuition fees are to be paid and will calculate annually the tuition fee to be paid based on Ministry of Education regulations.

~~4.0 — First Nations students who reside on a reserve who wish to attend a Thames Valley District School Board school not covered under a tuition agreement with a First Nations education authority are to pay tuition fees in accordance with the *Education Act*. Financial Services will calculate annually the tuition fee to be paid based on Ministry of Education regulations.~~

55.0 All student exchanges supported by the Thames Valley District School Board must be sponsored by an approved exchange organization. They shall be reciprocal in nature and, normally, fall within the same school year being September to August of each year.
