Dear Student,

Every high school student in Ontario must complete 40 hours of community involvement activities in order to receive an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). The purpose of the community involvement requirement is to encourage students to extend their skills beyond the classroom, utilize their interest and enthusiasm to benefit the community, gain valuable experiences working with volunteer groups and learning about service to people and organizations.

As of the 2020-2021 school year, students who are 14 years and older may record up to a maximum of 10 hours from paid employment towards their earned hours at the discretion of the Principal. Students counting paid employment towards their graduation requirement will be required to complete a reflection exercise indicating how their work contributed to the service for others.

In addition to completing the reflection below, your submission must include TVDSB’s “Completion of Community Involvement Activities” form.
