

A.E. JEFFERY AWARDS

1. ONE AWARD OF \$300.00 FOR A GRADUATING STUDENT
2. THREE AWARDS OF \$100.00 FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS



Criteria

1. The first award shall be given to a graduating student for scholarship and leadership both in school and in the community, and who is not otherwise receiving an award.
2. The second group of awards shall be given to three undergraduate students attaining high standards in specific areas of study, and who are not otherwise receiving any awards.

History

This fund was established in 1968 by Mr. A.E. Jeffery and these awards are now given in his memory. Mr. Jeffery was a former trustee and chairman of the London Board of Education in the 1960's. He was instrumental in the founding of Thames Valley Secondary School from concept to completion. When Thames S.S. closed, these funds were transferred to the new school B. Davison.
