The fund was established in memory of Carla (Mills) Cameron who died tragically following a horseback riding accident in Switzerland on June 9, 2006. Carla was an accomplished and competitive athlete. She participated in many sporting activities including basketball, badminton, horseback riding, cross country running and rowing. Carla was an excellent student. She graduated with first-class honours from Mountsfield Public School, South Secondary School, Queens University and the Canadian College of Naturopathic Medicine. She chose Naturopathic Medicine so that she could help and heal others with a preventative practice of medicine. Carla was also an avid traveller and had the opportunity to visit many places in her lifetime.
