Criteria

- A) One award to a student entering a traditional post-secondary Fine Arts program.
- B) One award to a student entering any other post-secondary Visual Arts program which may include Graphic Arts, Photography, Design and Technology.

The students must have completed three (3) full years at an Elgin County Secondary School. Students must submit 4 works of art with their application.

Established in 1990 by the McDougall family in memory of the late Clark McDougall, a well-known St. Thomas artist, to encourage and assist young Elgin County artists to pursue a post-secondary fine arts education.

Selection Process

The recipients will be determined by a selection committee comprised of a designated staff member of the St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre and two other art professionals, such as artist-instructors from post-secondary school institutions or other public art gallery personnel. Additional committee members will be appointed by the Art Gallery in consultation with the McDougall family.
