George Ernest Hurl chose to leave the family farm and join his peers, volunteering to join the Canadian World War 1 effort in 1916. After completing the training in Canada, he was transferred to England as a member of the 157th Canadian Expeditionary Force, and by the fall of 1916 he had been sent to France to be attached to an active combat battalion. During his two years of service in France he saw action in Arras, Passchendaele, and Vimy Ridge. He returned to Canada in early 1919 and settled in Midland, Ontario going on to start a family and a successful business. This bursary is dedicated to the memory of all who have sacrificed so that others could live free.
