History

Established in 2020 in honour of the late Ghias and Rizwana Zaki by their children, in whom they instilled the importance and value of education.

Name pronunciations: Ghias [Ghay-oss] and Rizwana [Riz-wa-na] Zaki [Za-key].

Selection Process

All applications to be received and reviewed by the school's award selection committee. Criteria should be given equal weight, and applications should be reviewed with diversity, inclusion and equity principles in mind. One student should be recommended from each school.

Student Services Department submits the application of the recommended student to Jackie Ellefsen, by the determined deadline. Jackie Ellefsen forwards the three blinded (i.e. personal identifiers removed) applications to the selection committee. The selection committee will include – Kashif Zaki, Samira Zaki and Safa Zaki. The selection committee will determine the award recipient.
