Criteria

The Award will be presented annually to one student graduating from an Elgin County Secondary School of the Thames Valley District School Board who is entering a University science program involving the study of Botany. Dendrology with the goal of perhaps becoming an arborist or dendrologist, or pursuing a career in forestry. In the event there is not a suitable candidate in these fields a student pursuing a career in the fields of conservation or horticulture would be considered. Preference given to students with financial need. The award will be in the amount of \$1,000.00 to be applied towards tuition, and the student may re-apply annually for two further years, receiving up to \$3,000.00 in total over three consecutive years, if remaining eligible.
