Established under the direction of the O.P.P. Association in memory of Jack G. Ross, an Ontario Provincial Police Officer and valued member of the community, who gave his life in the line of duty on behalf of his fellow citizens of Woodstock.

Selection Process

The recipient will be determined by a committee consisting of two trustees representing the CEC East area of the Thames Valley District School Board and one representative designated by the O.P.P. Association.
