## History

Established in 2002 in memory of Jane Curry. Jane was a long time employee of the Thames Valley District School Board in Oxford County. Jane began her teaching career at Woodstock Collegiate Institute and, after spending some years at College Avenue Secondary School and Ingersoll District Collegiate Institute, left as Head of the Guidance Department at Woodstock Collegiate Institute.

## Selection Process

Students will apply online. Each school will identify one candidate to nominate for adjudication. Applications will be reviewed and a recipient chosen by a committee comprised of two local retired Thames Valley District School Board educators who knew Jane Curry and two members of Jane Curry's family. The Committee will select a candidate considering the following:

- primarily, the content, style and impact upon the committee of the essay accompanying each application
- secondly, financial need. This award will be presented at the Commencement Exercises of the recipient/s school. The presenter will be determined by Fred Curry. A recognition plaque will be maintained at Woodstock Collegiate Institute and updated on an annual basis.
