Criteria

Any graduating student with an academic average of at least 65% who will be enrolled in an agricultural college or university and taking an Agricultural program.

They must be a resident of Oxford County (graduates of secondary schools outside of Oxford County are eligible) with preference given to candidates enrolling in Crop Science and who display an interest in soil conservation.

All components of the criteria must be addressed on the application form.
