History

The Saunders Black Students' Association was founded in 2021. The SBSALA has been set up to recognize the students who work so hard to ensure that the Saunders Black Students' voices are heard at both the school and the board level and that lasting changes are initiated and implemented to create equitable learning environments for all. In addition, this award recognizes students for advocating for culturally relevant and responsive pedagogy in their classrooms and across schools.
