Criteria

A graduating student (Canadian citizen) enrolled in any Canadian community college, university or other post-secondary institution granting recognized certificates or degrees at the post-secondary level. The student must demonstrate qualities of good citizenship and have a wide range of Interests. Consideration will be given to academic records (best six credits at the University (U or M) level or best eight credits at the senior level). Preference will be given to students intending to enter the law enforcement field. Preference given to students who have remained in full time attendance over those returning to school after several years.

Established in 1991 from monies raised from various sources in memory of Scott Rossiter, a valued member of the Ingersoll community and a dedicated police officer with the Town of Ingersoll who gave his life in the performance of his duties.

Selection Process

Students will apply online. Each school will identify one candidate from the applications received to nominate for adjudication. The recipient will be determined by a committee comprised of one trustee representing the CEC East area of the Thames Valley District School Board, and one representative designated by the Oxford OPP.
