Criteria

Awarded to a graduating student, with preference being given to a student who has chosen either the trumpet or guitar as their instrument of choice, in which they have excelled at, and are pursuing Music or a Music related degree post-secondary within Canada, providing proof of registration. The student has also displayed dedication, commitment and excellence in performance.

In addition, preference is to be considered for a student having shown a need for financial assistance to continue their education. The candidate will be involved in a co-curricular and extra-curricular music program.

Note: Should there be no music student who fits the above criteria during a particular year, a graduating student who is entering the medical field in a nursing program, Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) or Bachelor of Nursing Degree (BN) may be considered.
