Selection Process

Students will apply online. Each school will identify one candidate from the applications received and nominate the applicant to TVEF for adjudication. The recipient will be determined by the Oxford Awards Selections Committee, including a Trustee representative of the CEC East area of the Thames Valley District School Board, a Magill family member and Thames Valley Education Foundation.

Criteria

A graduating student from a Woodstock secondary school (public or separate) who:

- Is proceeding to a program in Business or Economics at a registered Canadian university;
- Has a minimum of 75% in their graduating year
- Demonstrates qualities of good citizenship, involvement in school activities and/or community activities;
- Has a demonstrated Interest and/or proficiency in entrepreneurial activities;
- Has financial need (will be a consideration, not a requirement).
