Criteria

The award will be presented to a student who has demonstrated unusual capability or success in coping with a communicational, physical, intellectual, behavioral exceptionality, or multiple exceptionalities, or in spite of the impairment, has made a noteworthy contribution in any way to their school/community.

The student has demonstrated that a person with an impairment can lead a full and useful life as a student or adult.

The award will be granted only once to a student.

Selection Process

Each school nominates one student, and a Selection Committee including Special Education staff and teachers, as well as a principal and regular teaching staff will decide. At the discretion of the Selection Committee, the award may be granted to two deserving students.
