



Portable Washrooms during Community Use hours

Outdoor space rentals do not include access to school washrooms unless listed on the permit. Custodial overtime rates will be applied to the permit for groups requesting washroom access when a custodian is not on duty, such as summer evening permit times.

Community Use rental groups may request permission to place portable washrooms on TVDSB property through the online permit. The rental group will incur all costs and is responsible for arranging the rental, drop off, maintenance and pick up of the portable washroom.

The location of the portable washroom on school property is to be approved by the TVDSB Maintenance department. A Maintenance representative must be present when the portable washroom is dropped off. The washroom must be secured to a permanent fixture such as a fence or lamp post. If stakes/pegs or wires are being used to secure the structure, they are to be marked with reflective paint or tape to ensure visibility. Maintenance will determine whether a stakeout of lines is required. When not in use, the washroom must be locked.

The company name with contact information that the structure is being rented from must be clearly posted on the outside of the portable washroom. This information is to be provided to Community Use on the permit.
