



What you need to know about English Anytime

What is English Anytime?

- a course that is a mix of online Google meets with the instructor and online self-guided learning.

Who benefits from taking English Anytime?

- A learner caring for young children at home.
- A learner who works shifts
- A learner who can't attend a regular 5-day virtual class
- A learner who can't attend a regular 2-night virtual class
- A learner who can only study on Saturday or Sunday
- A learner who has difficulty studying long periods of time on a computer

What do you need?

- Reliable internet service (wifi or ethernet)
- A reliable computer or laptop (a loaned chromebook is available)
- A school Gmail account (assigned after registration)

How does this class work?

- You need to plan to attend a Google Meet (with other learners) per week
- The Google Meet will be scheduled on Fridays (late afternoon or evening).
- The instructor will teach a lesson and have you complete an activity with other learners.
- The instructor will assign additional assignments in a learning platform for you to complete on your own time.
- You need to complete these assignments on your own, at your own time in the week
- Plan to study **5 or more hours per week.**
- If you need help, you can email the instructor or arrange to meet online.

Q&A

Q: I am caring for children at home.

A: Suggest you schedule your Google Meet when the children are napping or when another adult can look after the children. Complete your assignments after they go to bed.

Q: I am a shift worker. Sometimes I work mornings, sometimes afternoons, sometimes nights. I can't attend classes regularly.

A: You can change your Google Meet time to suit your work schedule.

Q: I can't look at the computer screen for long periods of time. I have sight problems.

A: Spread out your self-guided study – do a little bit at a time each day.

If at any time during the class it is determined that a learner cannot participate fully because they do not meet expectations, the learner will be removed from the class and placed on a waitlist for a hybrid (partly online) or in-person class.
