- There are 12 units. Some units are short (2-3 hours), and some are longer, (8-10 hours). You should complete ALL the units.
- You can complete the units in your own time and pace. You can repeat activities as many times as you like. The units include quizzes, games and readings. They will help you prepare for the citizenship test. There is an assessment task in each unit that you can only do ONCE.
- When you completed all the units in the course, you will receive a certificate of completion.

- ✓ an active email account
- ✓ ability to work independently on your own
- ✓ CLB 4 or higher in all four skills
