SUMMER SCHOOL -- New Credit eLearning Program

June 29, 2026, to July 24, 2026

New Credit Grade 9 to 12 summer eLearning courses are open to Thames Valley District School Board (TVDSB) secondary day school students including students starting at a TVDSB school in September 2026, and TVDSB adult students who are working towards completing their Secondary School Diploma.

Registration starts Monday March 23, 2026, at 08:00 am and closes Tuesday June 16, 2026, at 08:00 am.

*****Late registrations will not be accepted.***

It is recommended that students register early to secure a spot in their preferred course.

Once a course is full, the course will be removed as an option to select.

Students under 18 years of age must have parent/legal guardian approval to register for summer school.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS: *Students who are currently required to pay International Fees to attend regular day school* will also be required to pay a fee for Summer School. This fee must be paid prior to registering for a summer eLearning course. The **2026 fees** are as follows:

- **\$1940.00 for a full credit course OR 2 half credit courses**
- **\$970.00 for a half credit course**

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Students may only take ONE Summer School New Credit Course, regardless of the mode of delivery. This can be one full-credit course or two half-credit courses (e.g. Civics, Careers).
2. Students who have a high degree of self-motivation and the ability to work independently are best suited for eLearning courses.
3. As in traditional classes, regular attendance in eLearning is critical for success at summer school. Students must log in every school day (Monday to Friday) and are expected to spend 5.5 hours per day on their eLearning course, plus additional time for assignments and studying for tests and exams. All work must be completed and submitted as instructed by the eLearning teacher. Students are expected to keep up with the course material, due dates, and time commitments each week. ***Students who do not login to their eLearning course regularly risk being removed from the course for failing to meet the requirements.***
4. TVDSB reserves the right to cancel courses if there is insufficient enrolment. Students/parents/legal guardians will be notified by email if a course they registered for is cancelled.
5. Summer eLearning students are expected to adhere to the standard rules of academic integrity, the same as expected of students in a classroom setting.
