Fundraisers & Family Involvement – (Ashley & Julianne)

- A movie night or similar first family event of the year proposed for fall of next year.
- Hockey game: 53 tickets sold, with \$344.50 in profit. Next time choose a non-playoff game and make sure to avoid the game when the choir sings.
- Easter baskets: Went very well. Next time advertise more widely.
- Harvey's / Swiss Chalet night: Jessica will take signs and make sure they are displayed. Event runs 3-7 p.m.
- Cake Walk: Friday, May 8. Start at 9:20. Kindergarteners get 15 minutes, but other classes will need to be doubled up so that we can finish the walk portion by noon and have plenty of time to pull the winners' names.
 - Prep Day: Monday, May 4 at 9 a.m. in the maker space. Talked about ways to streamline the prep, including volunteers cutting the tickets at home beforehand.
 - Get tables set up the night before.
 - Families can send in nonperishables ahead of time.
 - We'll have a gluten- and dairy-free table. We need to clearly define who can put their ballots in for those items.

- Every student gets 2 free ballots.
- A few volunteers should come at 8:30 on Cake Walk day to help set up donations. Also someone needs to go to each class first thing in the morning to sell tickets for kids with cash.
- We need some extra boxes for kids to take cakes home in.
- Fun Fair: Wednesday, June 17th. New photo booth vendor: \$698, unlimited 2x6 prints, no props. Slams pizza, with all pizza coming at the same time. Ask Mme Shearer about band playing. Tattoos, bubbles, chalk, games, chips, water, and any other swag (like remaining jibbitz and popcorn) on offer, with freezies for dessert.. Grade 9 volunteers will be invited.

Principal Report – (Tammy)

There have been numerous events, including the dance showcase, Manie Musicale voting and assembly, the Eric Walters author visit. Upcoming events include a grades 1-5 trip to see Matilda at Mary Wright and Track and Field Day May 5 (rain date May 6). We have been asked to cancel hot lunches for Track and Field Day. Grades 4 and up participate in Track and Field. Planning is underway for next year.

Teacher Report – (Janice)

Mme Lapierre has requested a soccer field line painter (\$375), duct tape for marking during Track and Field and ribbons for 1st-6th place (total \$350). She anticipates needing about \$400 each year for Track and Field expenses, which in the past has been paid for out of the school budget.
