Background Information

East Carling PS

- On-The-Ground capacity of 461 pupil places.
- School had to be capped for the 2024-25 school year because of enrolment pressure.

Prince Charles PS

- On-The-Ground capacity of 602 pupil places.
- Interim accommodation school for East Carling PS.
- Has capacity to accommodate additional students in the future.

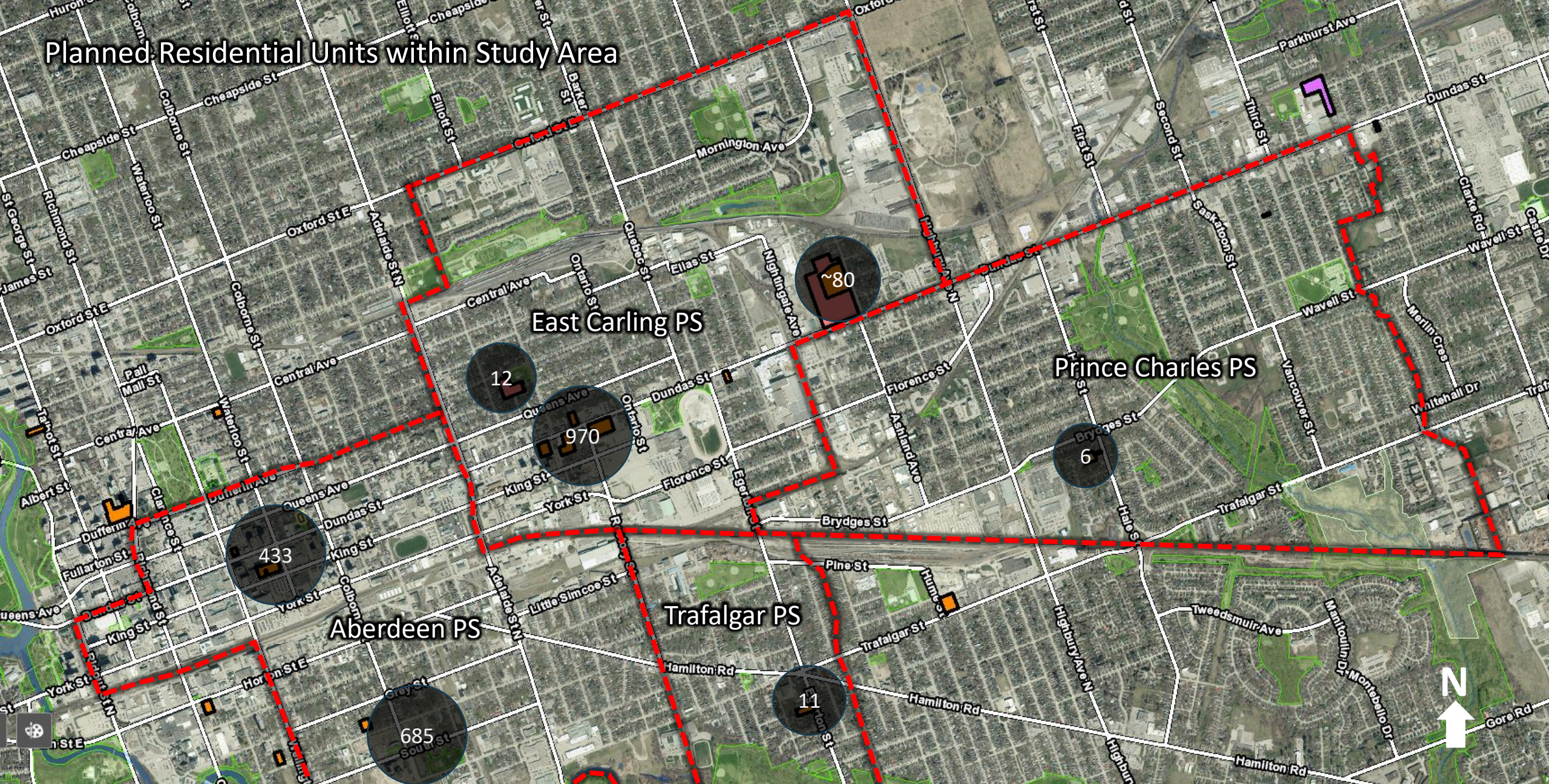
Aberdeen PS

- On-The-Ground capacity of 378 pupil places.
- Re-development of former Victoria Hospital site will contribute students and enrolment pressure to this school.

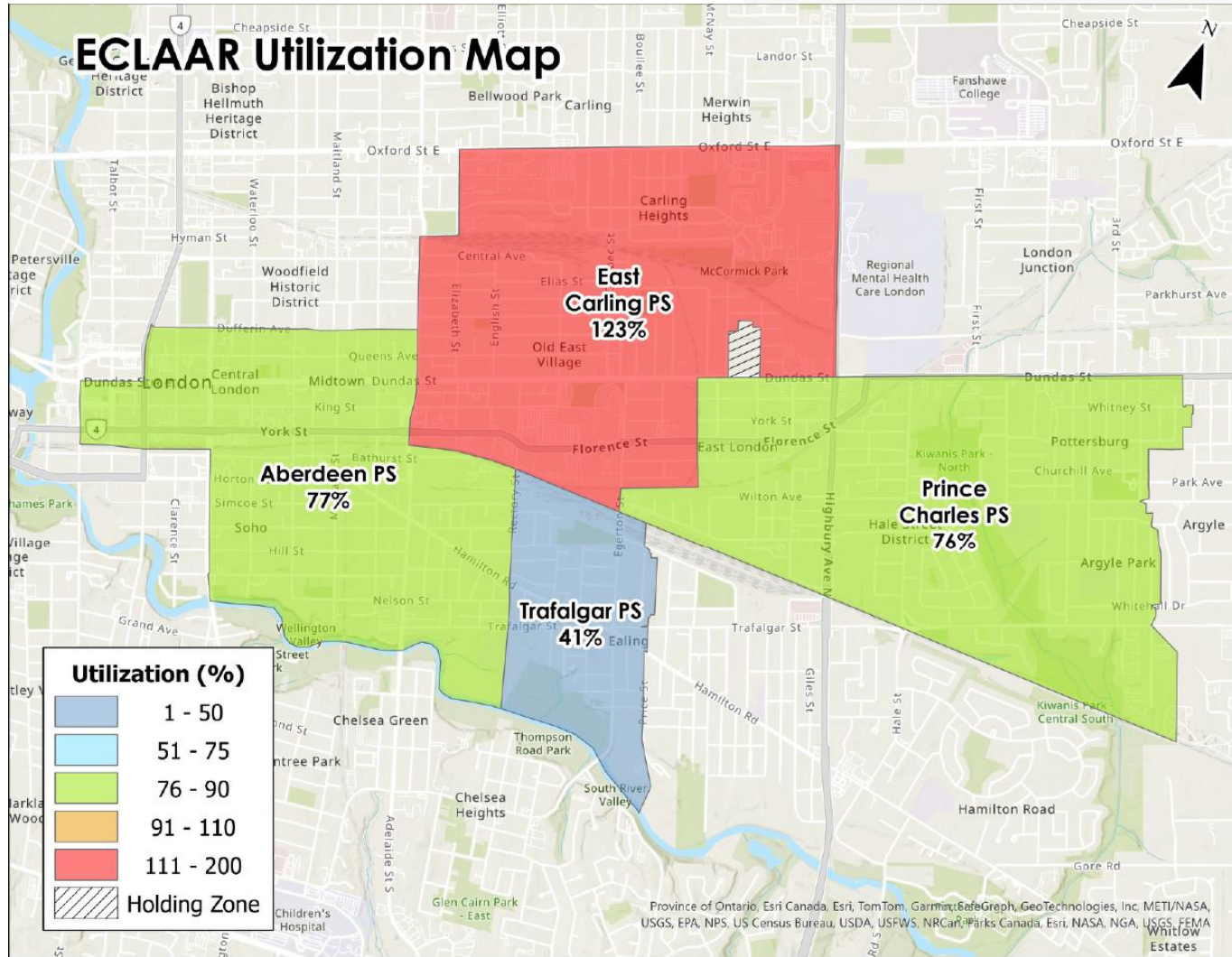
Trafalgar PS

- On-The-Ground capacity of 409 pupil places.
- Currently underutilized and has room to accommodate additional students in the future.

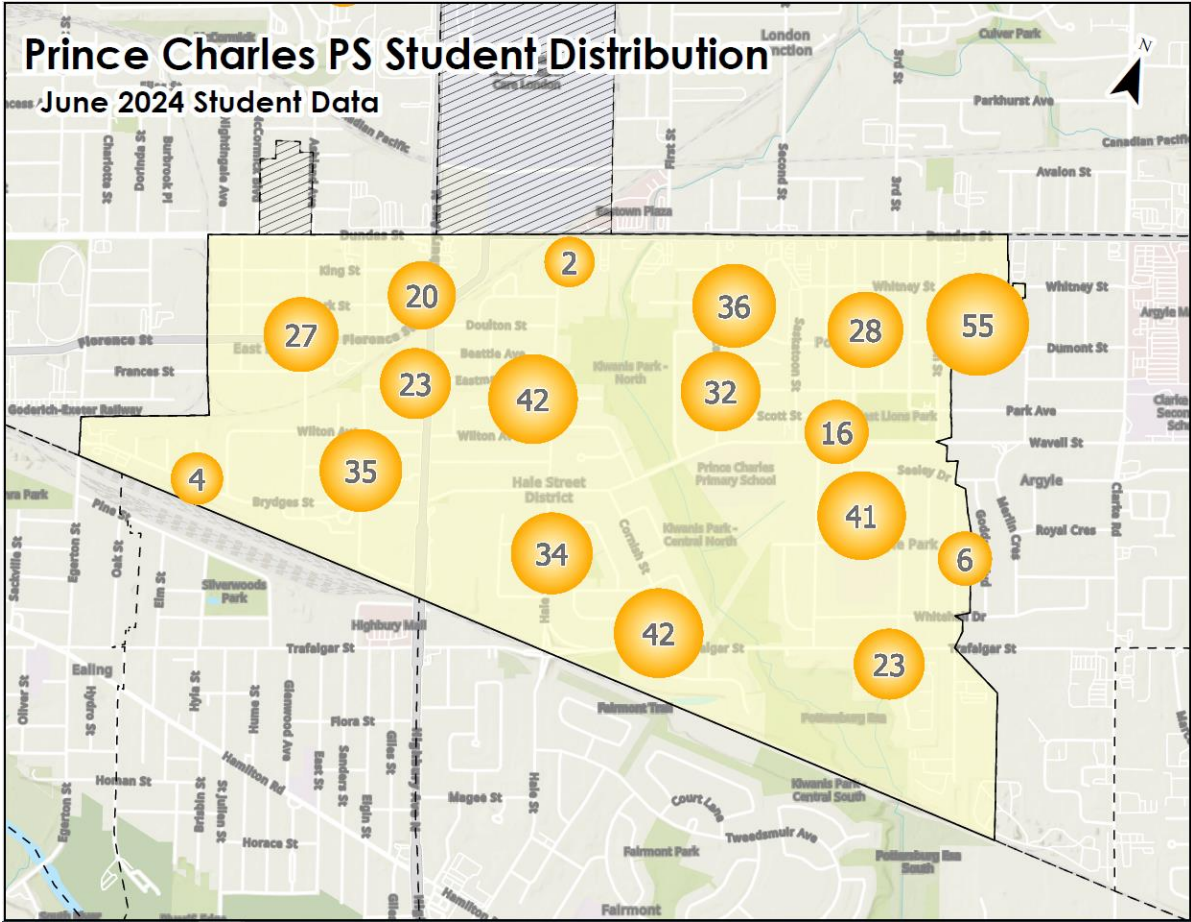
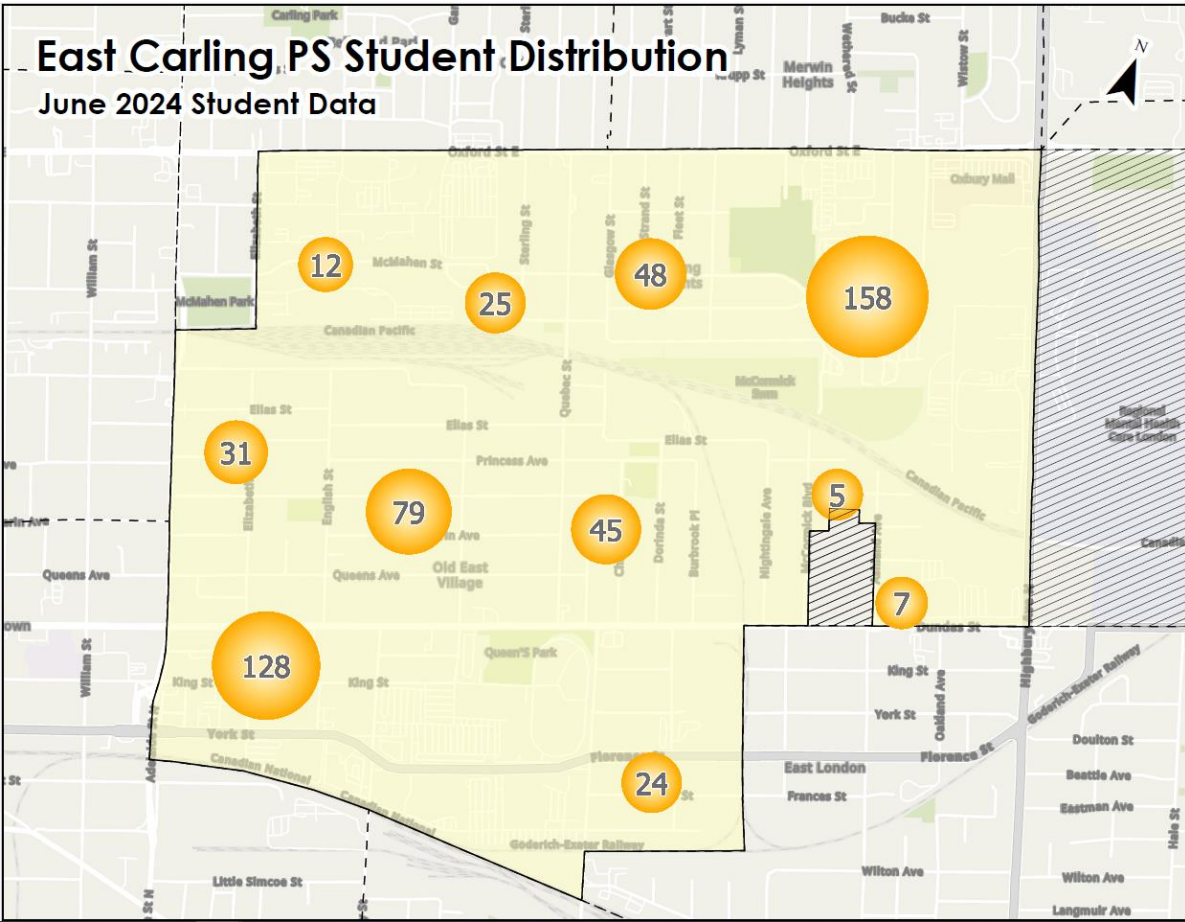
Planned Residential Units within Study Area

2023-2024 Student Distribution Maps

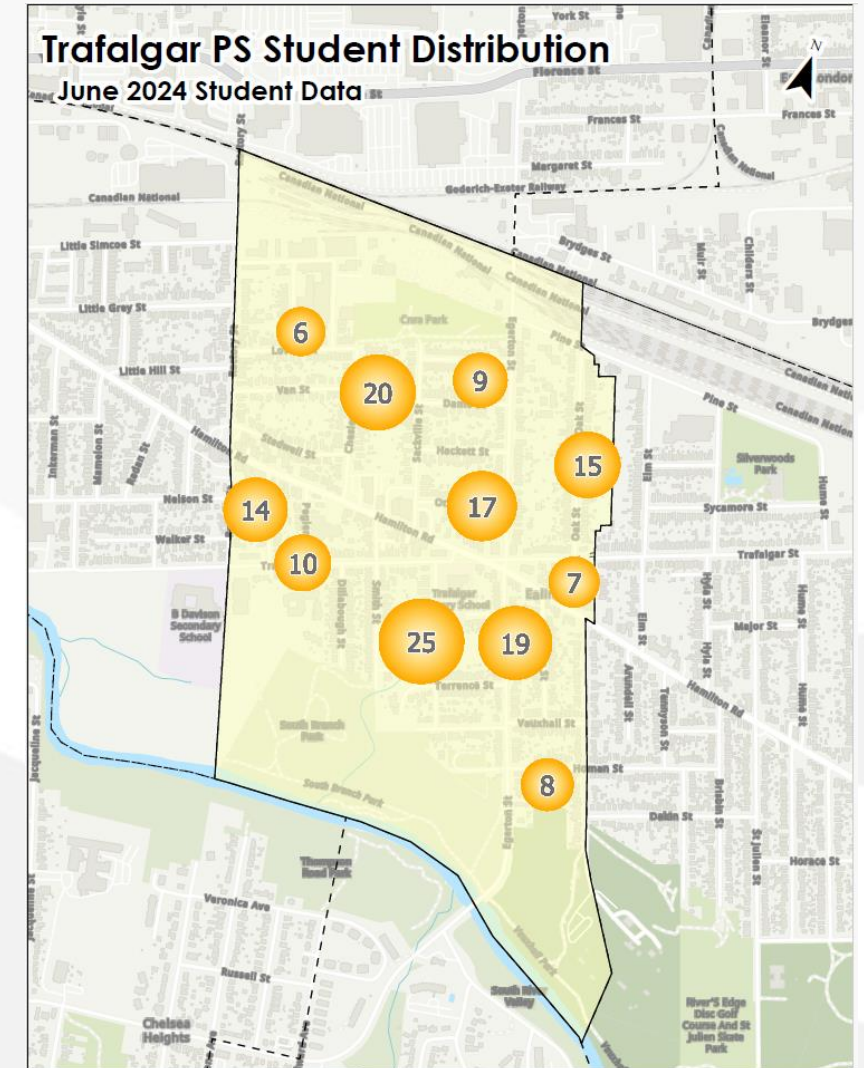

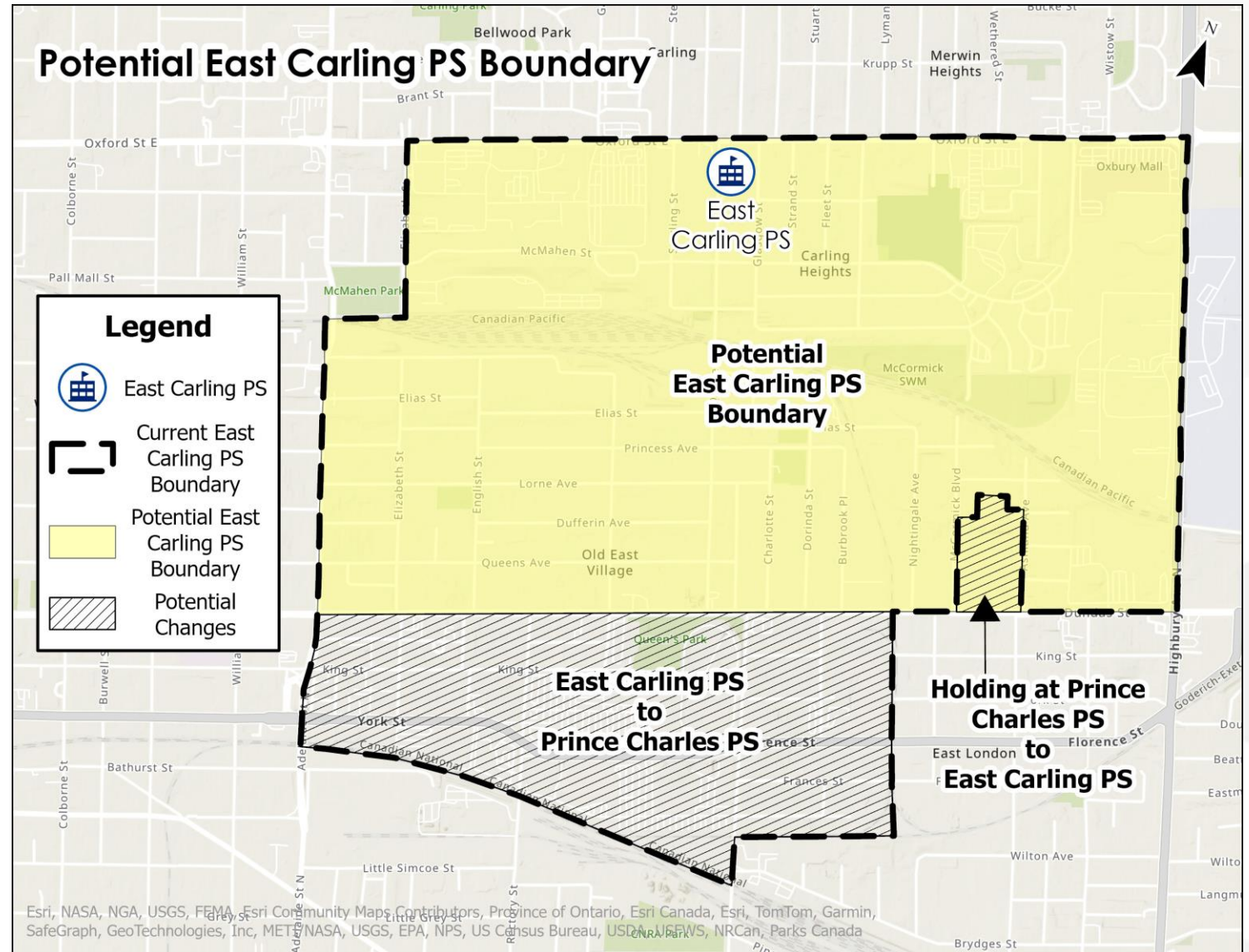

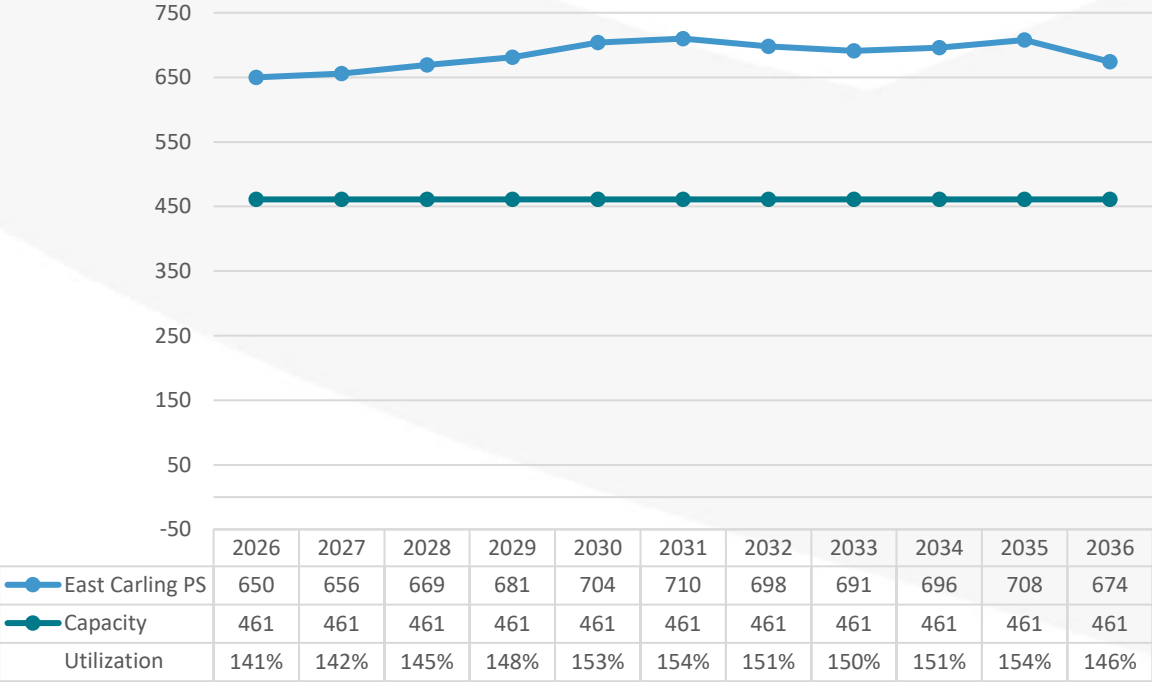

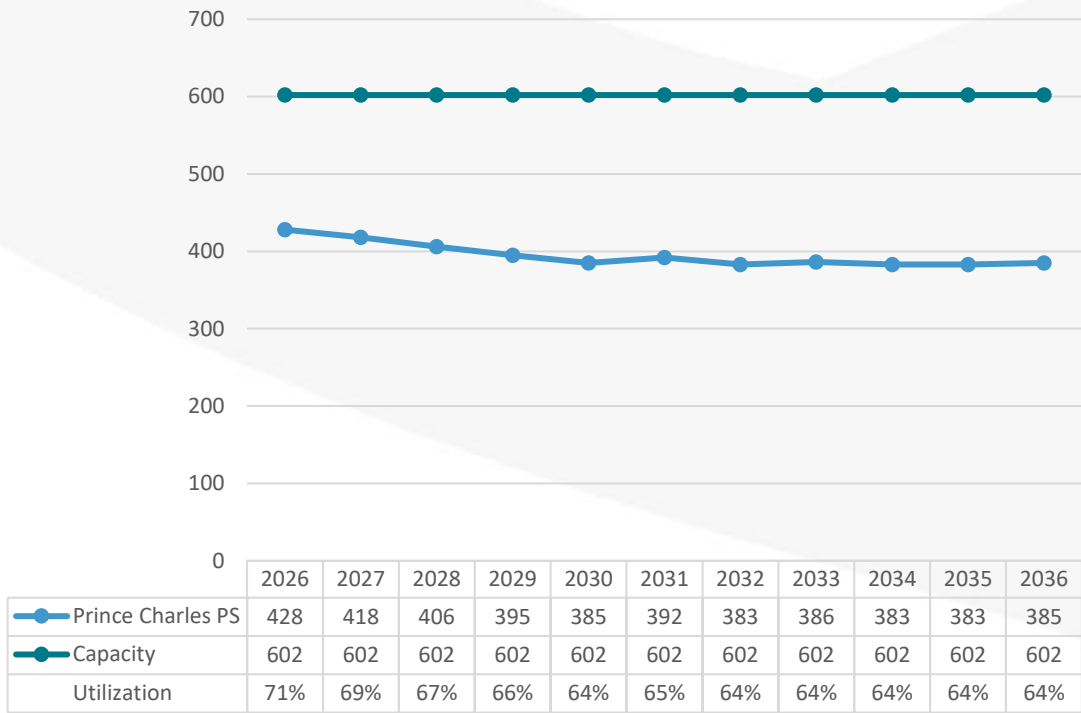

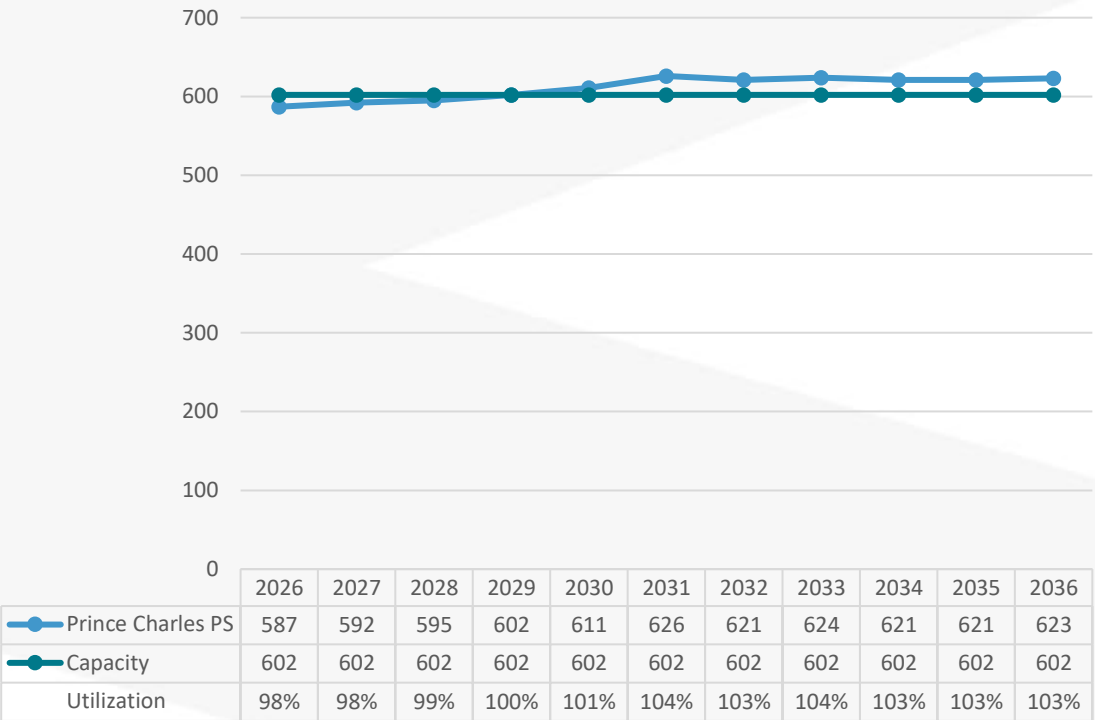

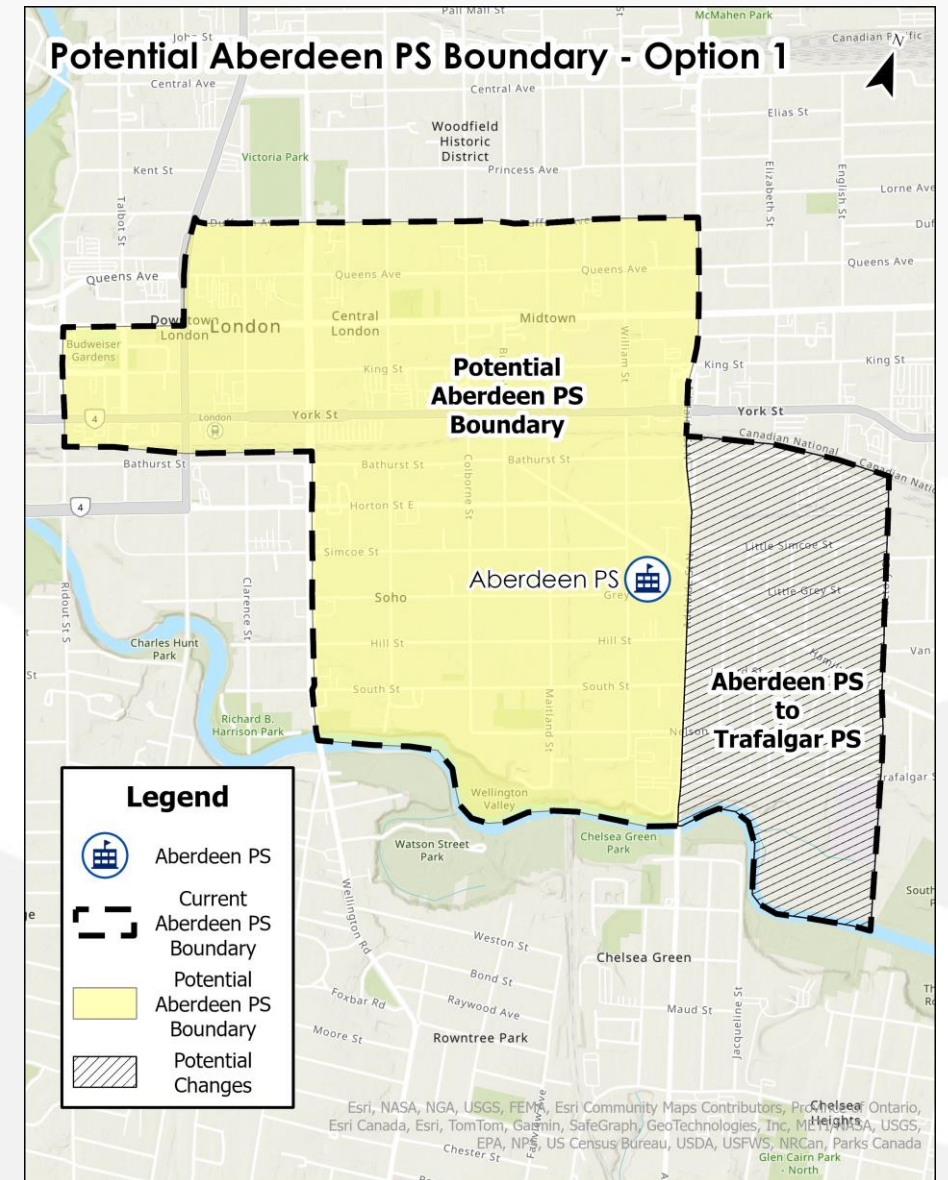

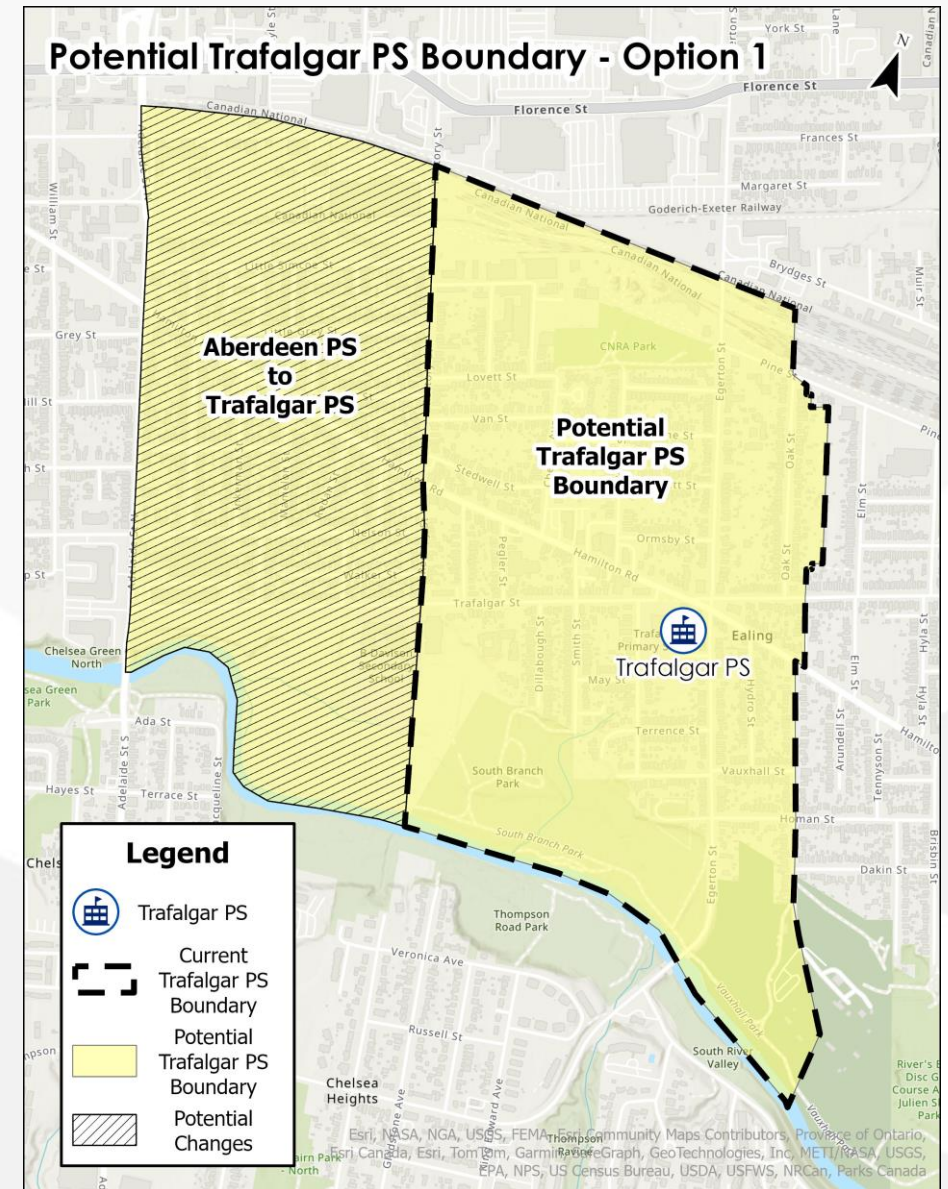

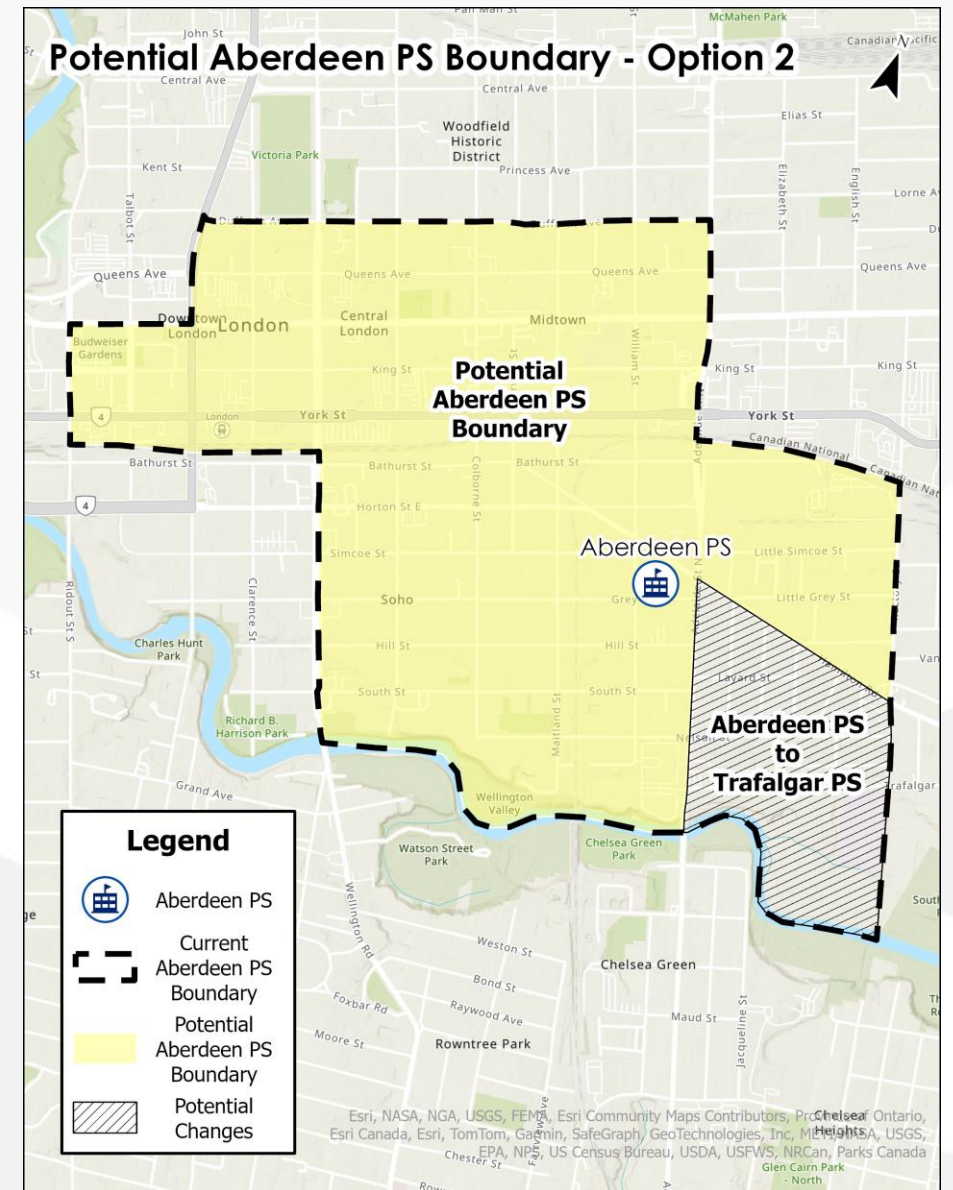
Proposed Aberdeen PS Option 1



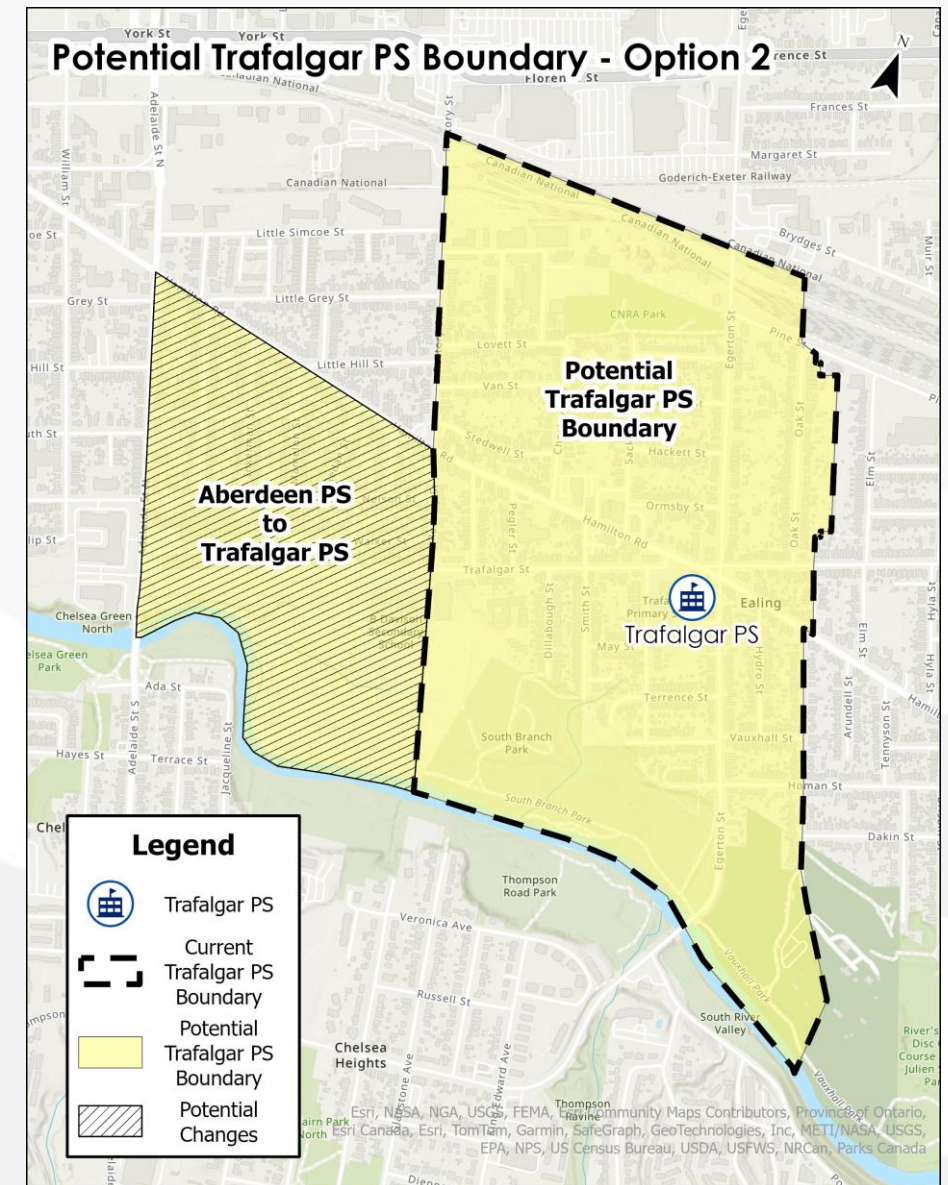
Proposed Trafalgar PS Option 1

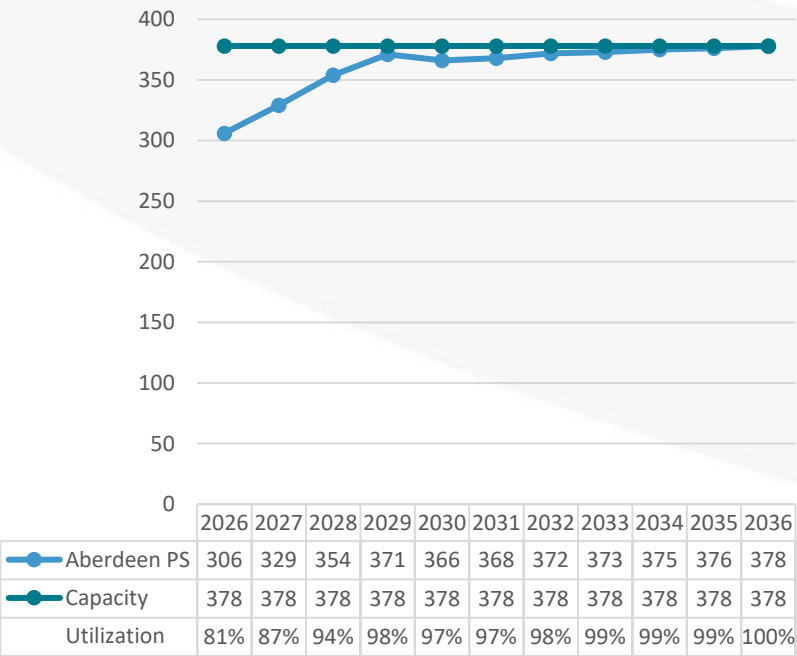

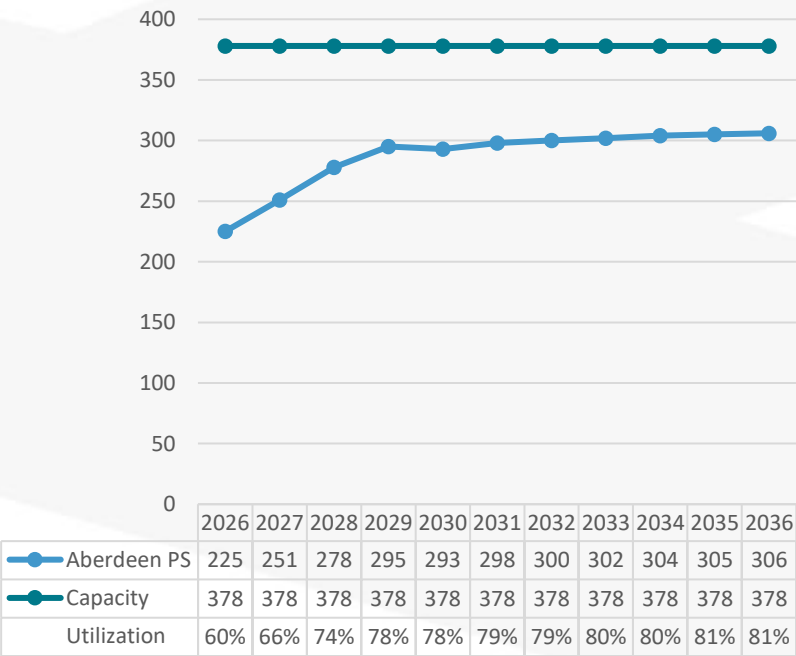

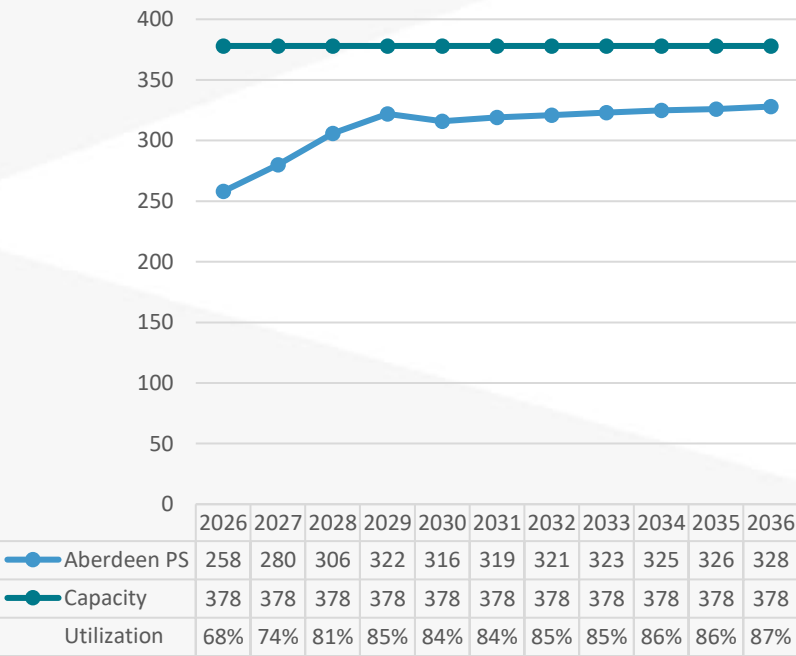

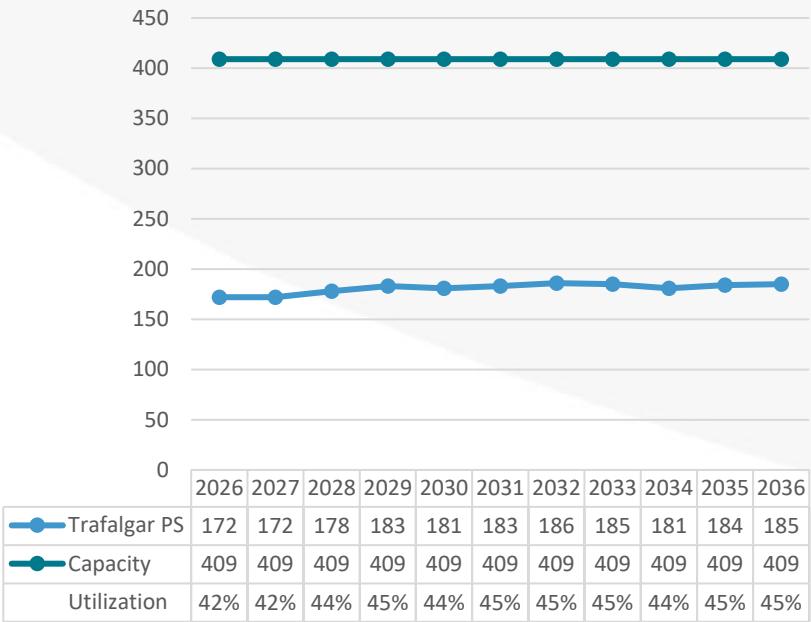

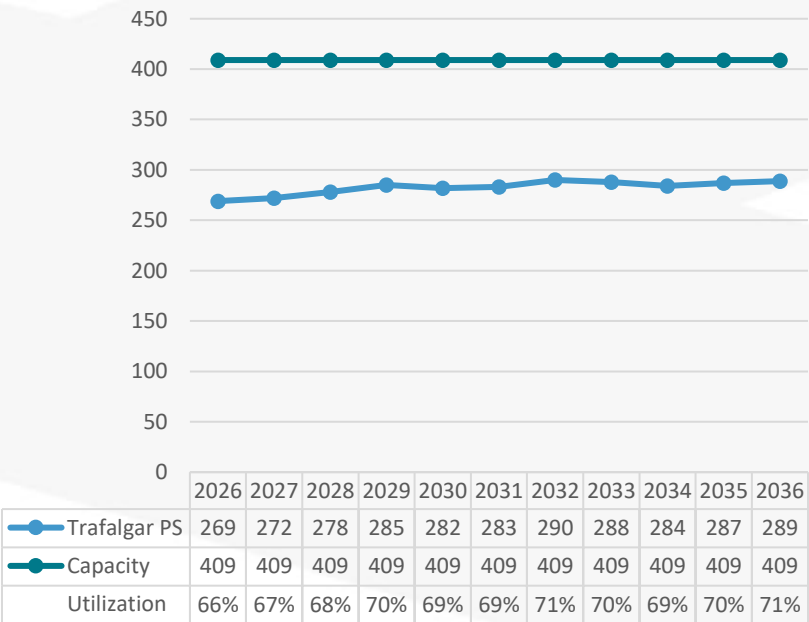

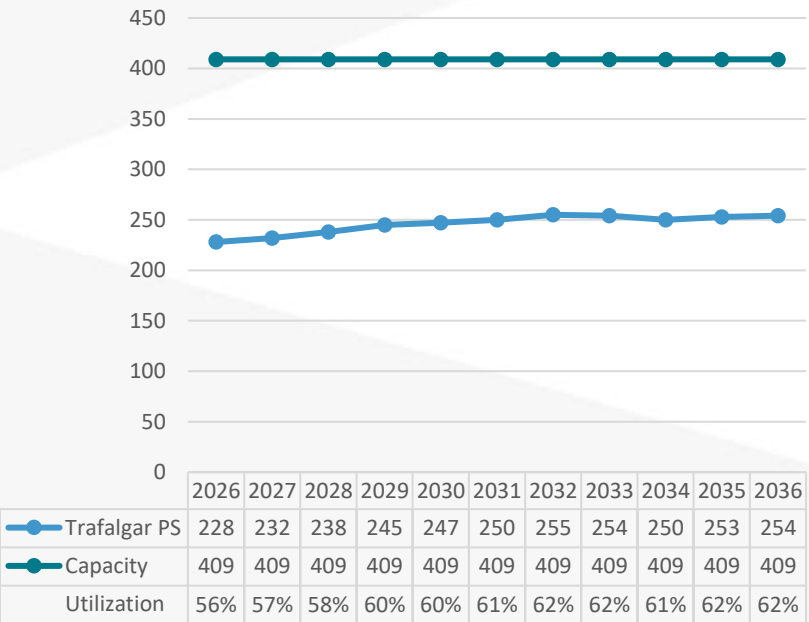
