On-The-Ground capacity of 553 pupil places. School had to be capped to new registrations in opening year of operation (2022-23) because of enrolment pressure.

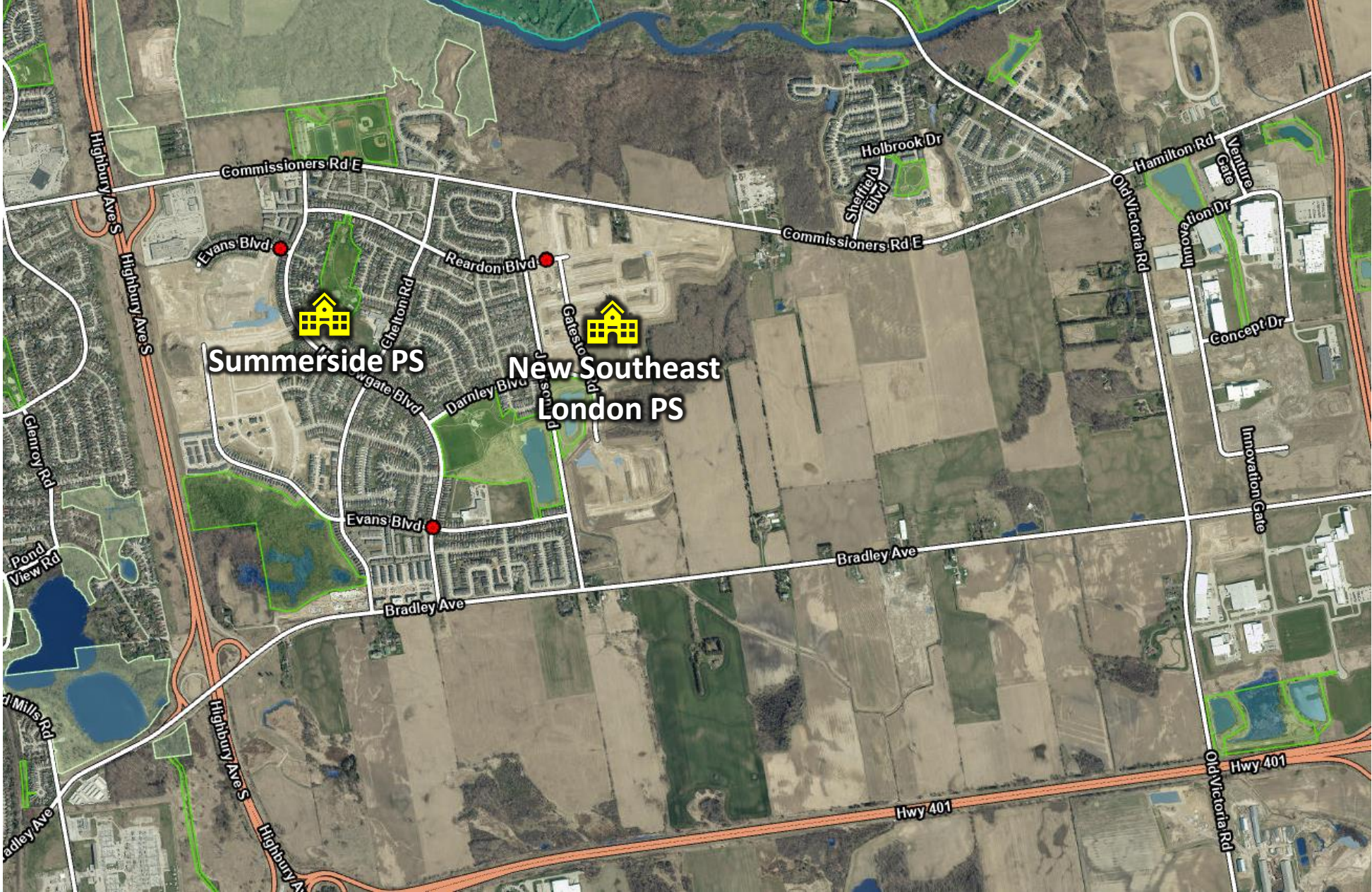
John P. Robarts PS

Interim accommodation school for Summerside PS. No attendance area changes proposed for this school as part of this review.

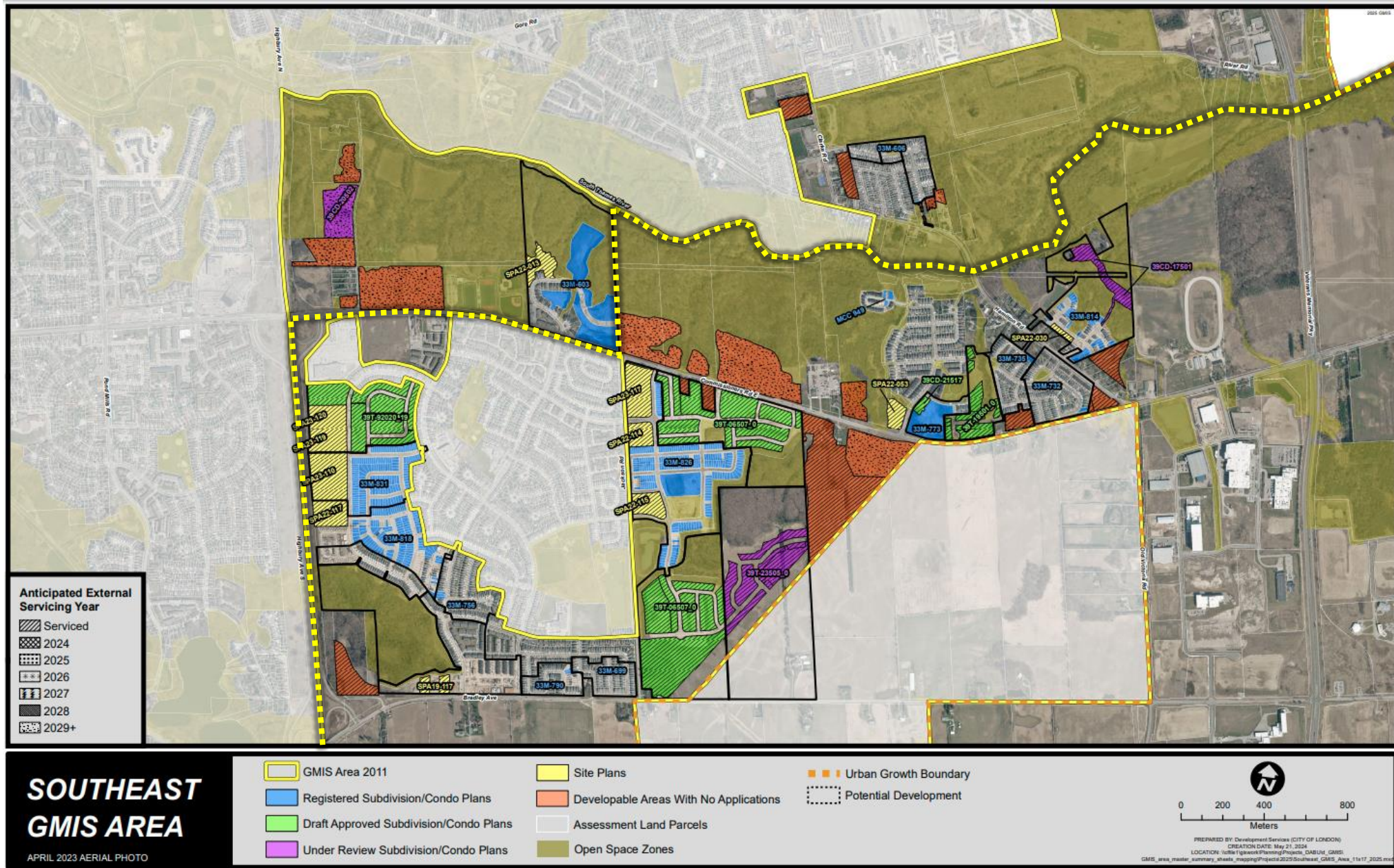
New Southeast London PS

Will have an On-The-Ground capacity of 655 pupil places. New residential development will contribute to growth of this school after opening.

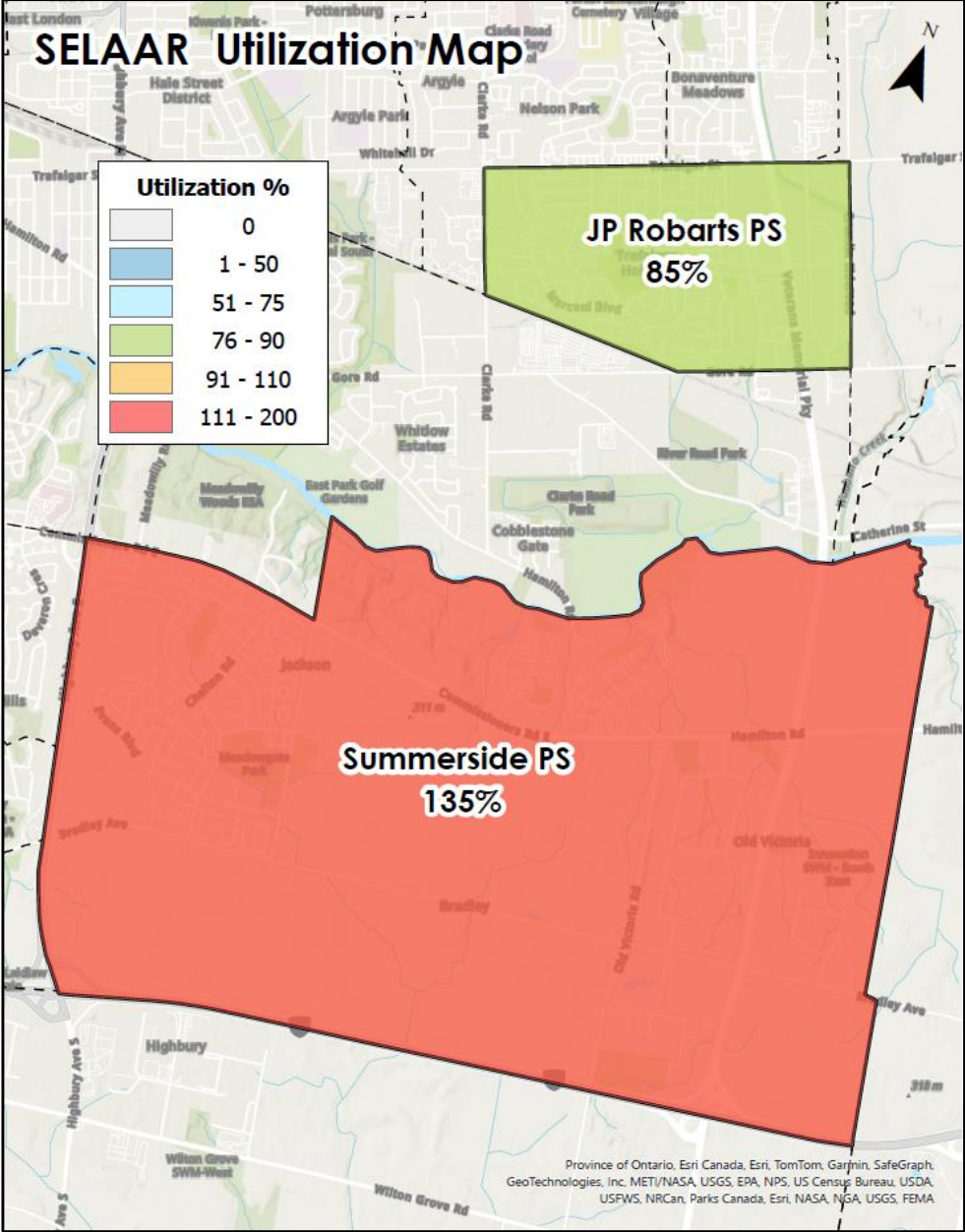
Context Map



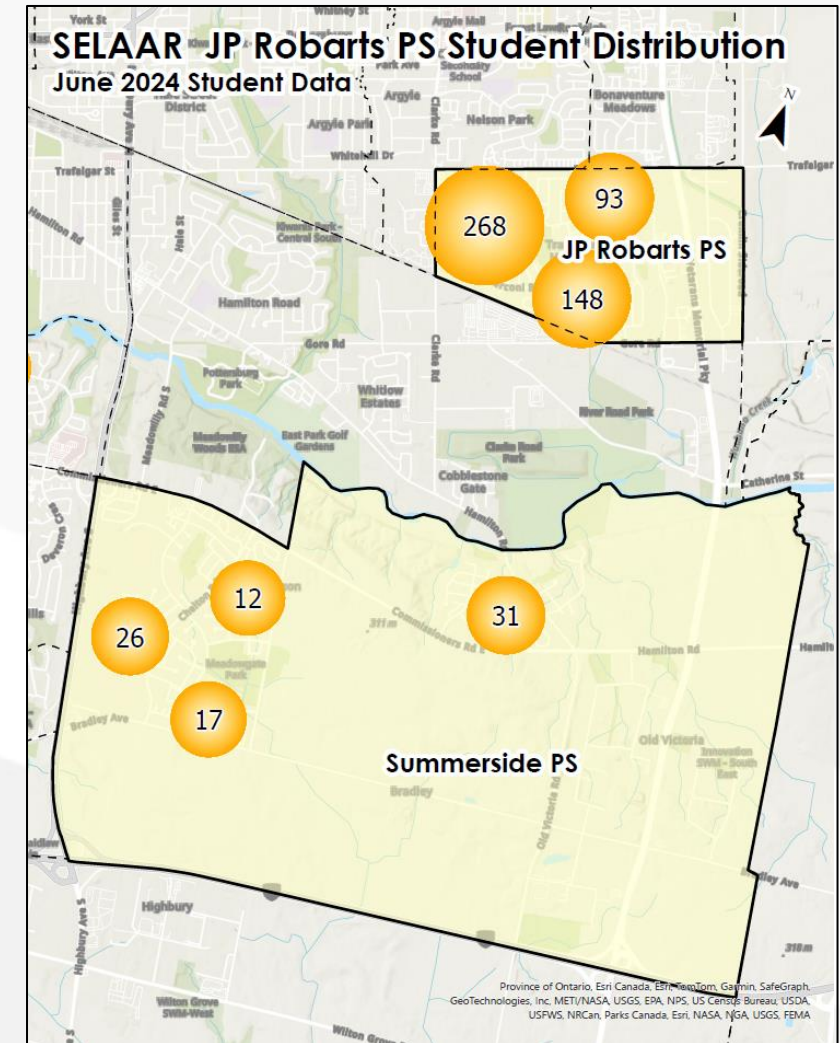
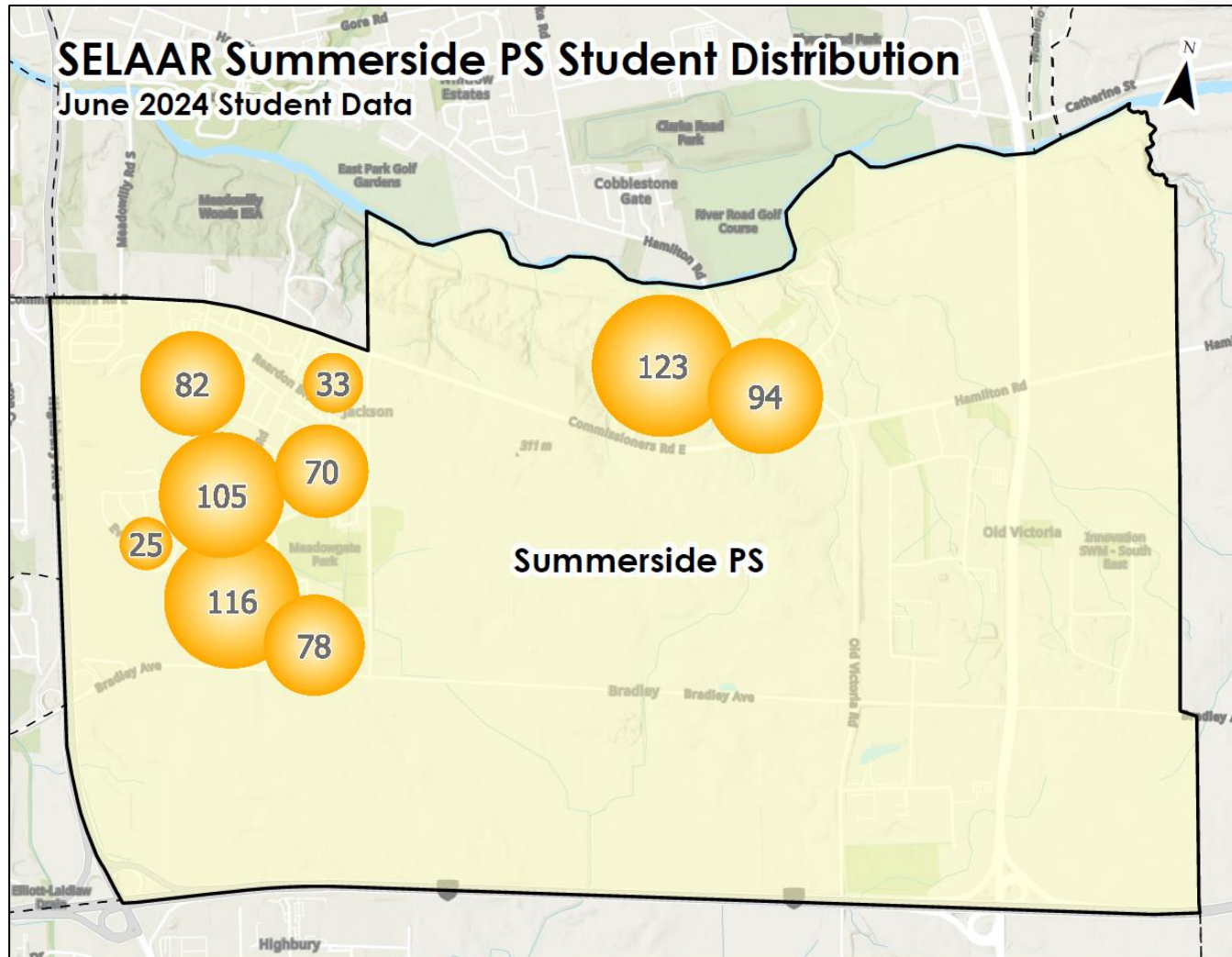
Development Map



2023-2024 Utilization Map



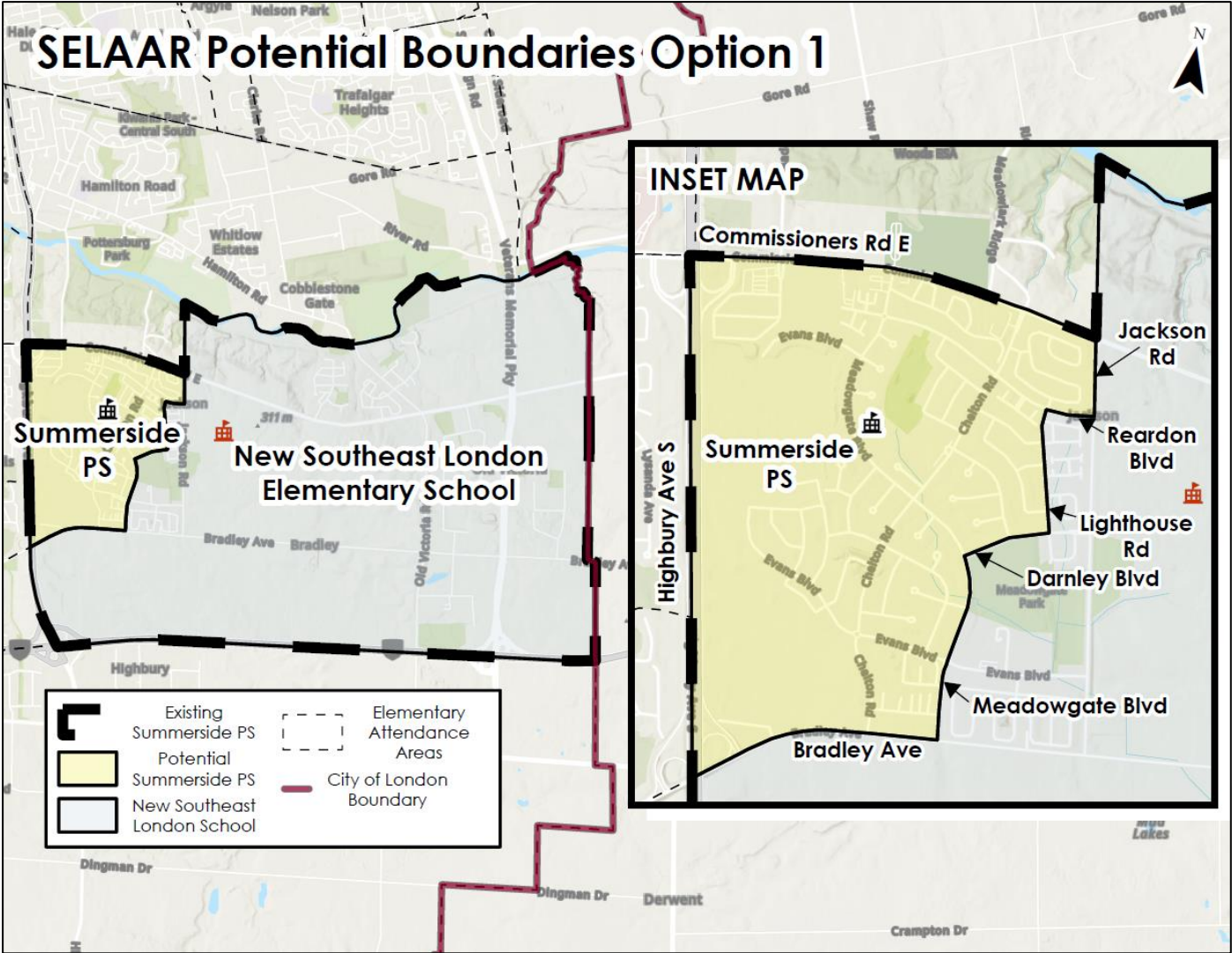
2023-2024 Student Distribution Maps

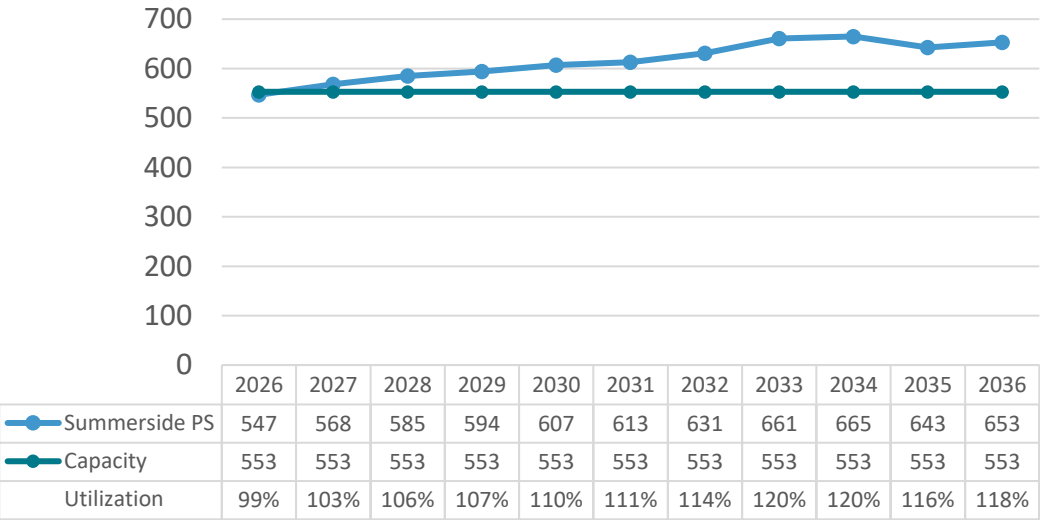

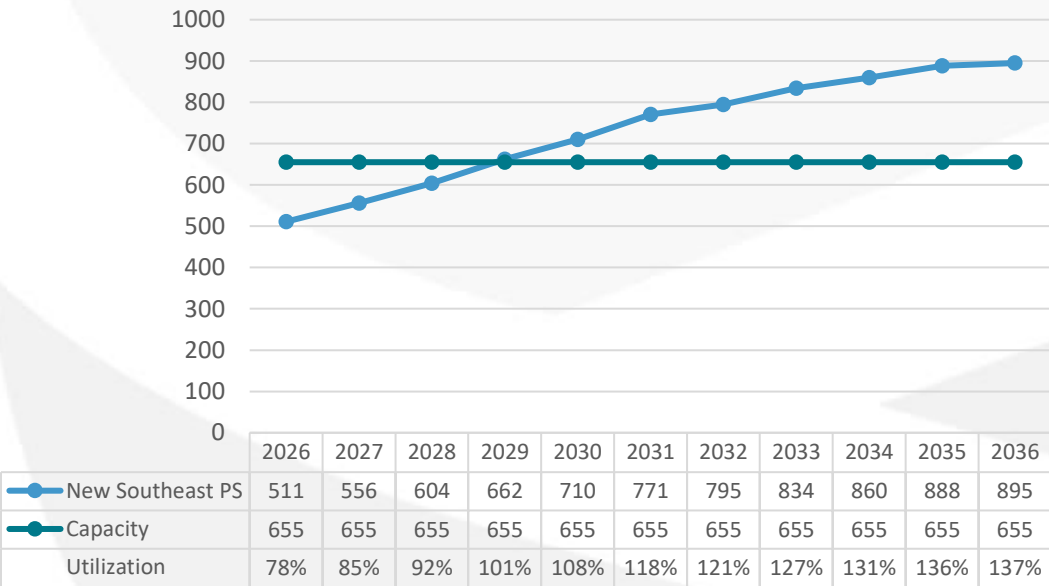

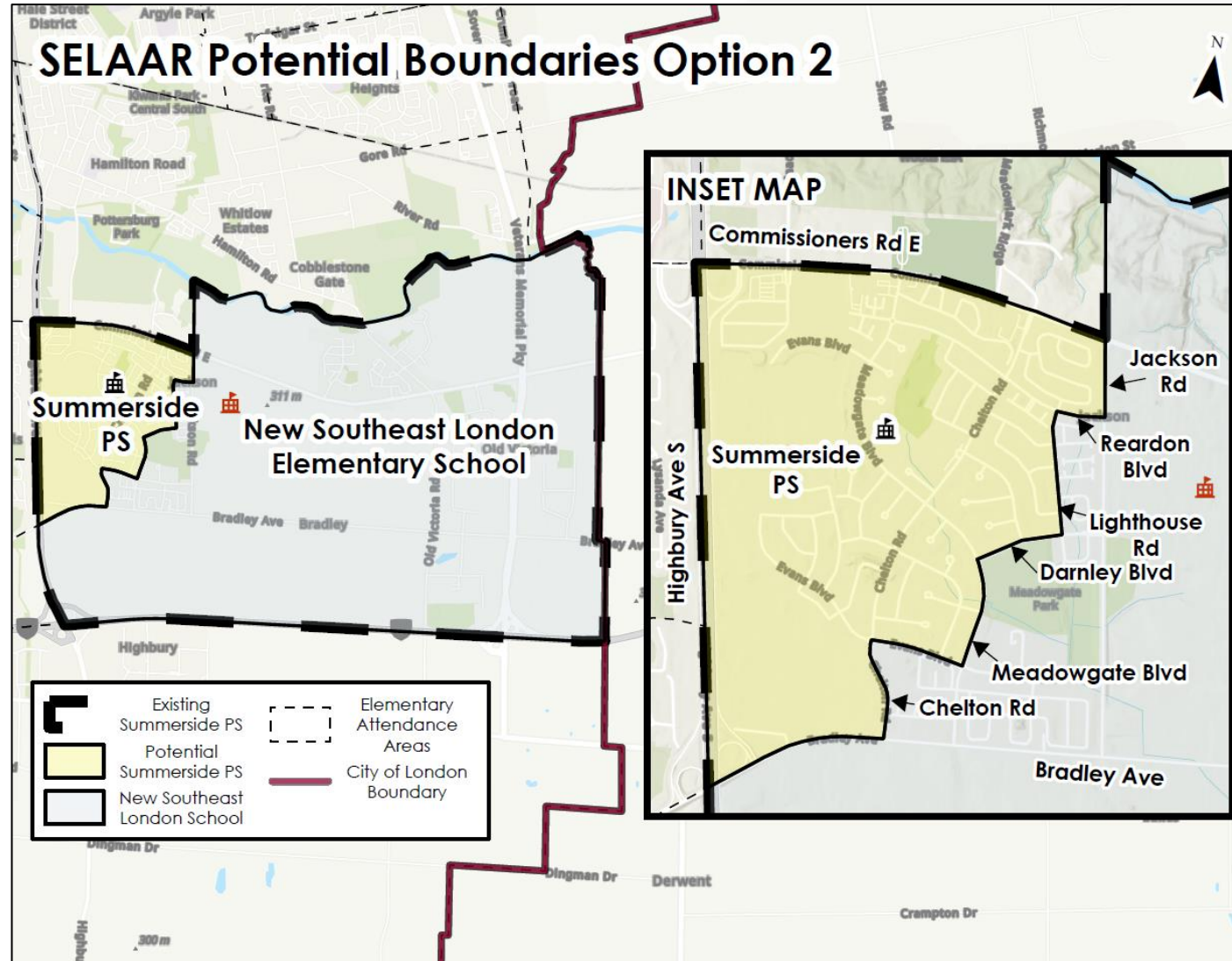
Summerside PS Option 1



New Southeast London PS Option 1

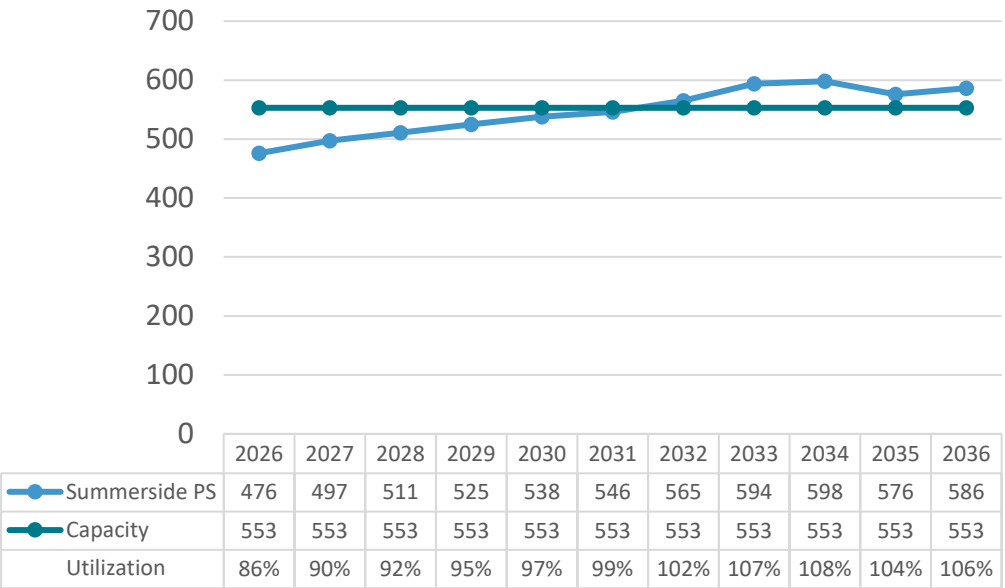

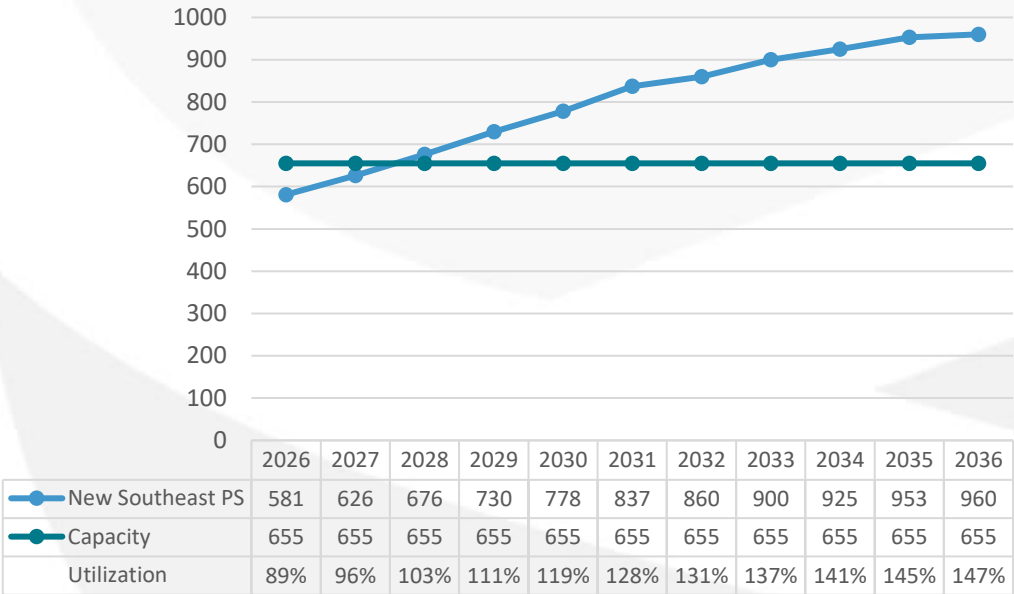
